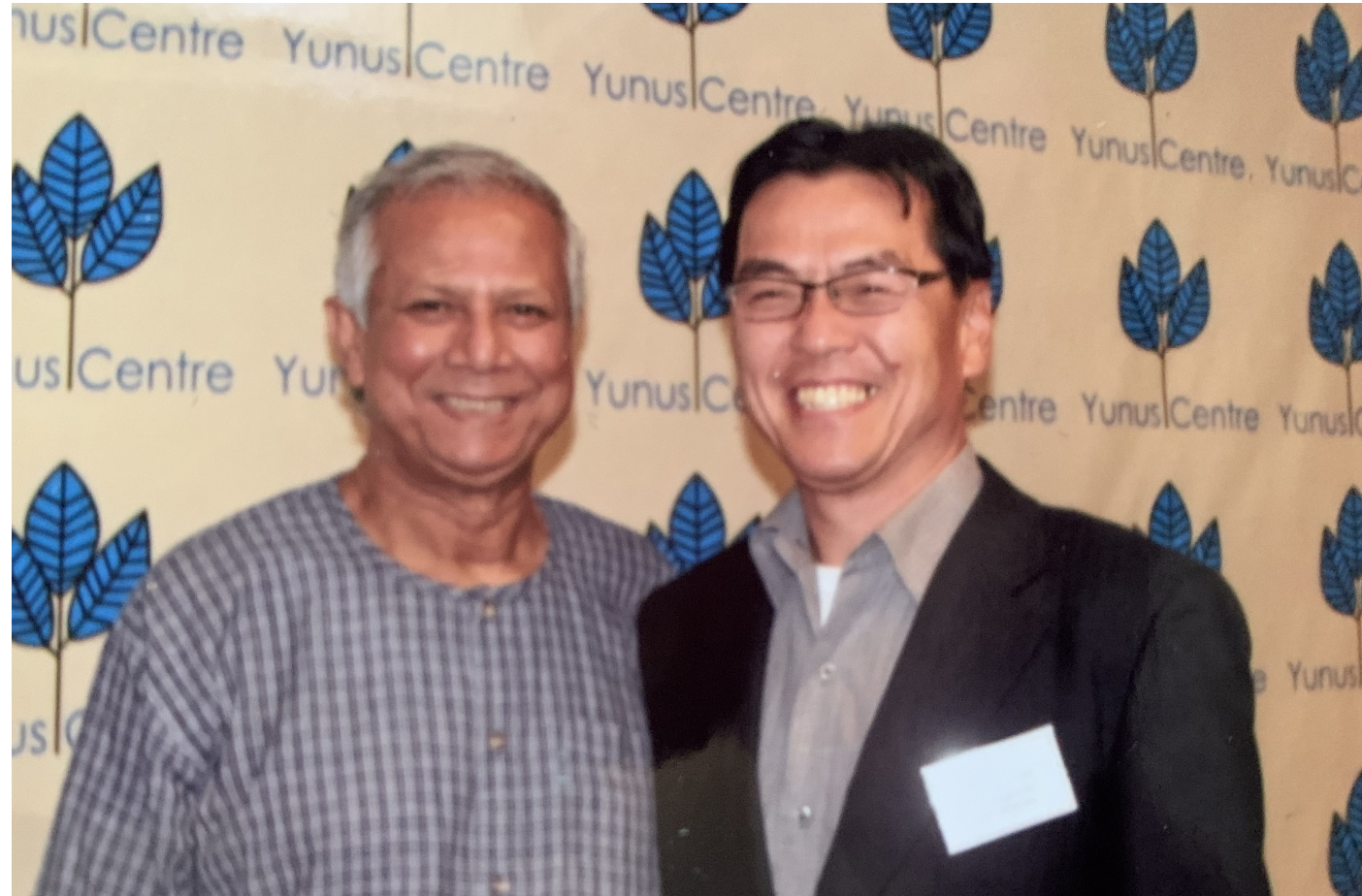

1. Our Mission

To empower disadvantaged youth in developing countries by providing them with scholarships so that they can overcome poverty and become valued members of their communities.

2. About us

- Inspired by Dr Yunus, Chief Adviser of Bangladesh, that education is the key to breaking the cycle of poverty in 2012.
- Founded in 2013 in a Japanese community in Sydney.
- Registered with NSW Fair Trading in 2013.
- Started to support students from Angel Home, a Japanese charity-run orphanage in Bangladesh, in 2015.
- Registered with ACNC (Australian Charities and Not-for-Profits Commission) in 2016.
- Expanded its support to students in Kenya in 2017.



3. Three Guiding Principles

1. Scholarships

Scholarships are the most effective way to provide access to higher education to underprivileged students in developing countries.

2. Minimum Overhead Expenses

Thanks to our dedicated volunteers and board members, our overhead expenses stay below 10% of the fundraising revenue. Every dollar donated reaches the students.

3. Long-term Vision

We support our students for 3-4 years until they become fully qualified. In return, they will help those in need throughout their careers.

4. Our Partner in Japan

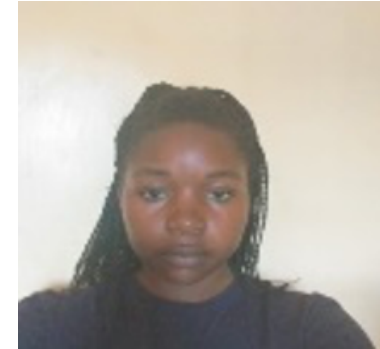

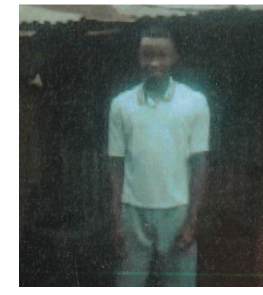
